

FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

This First Amendment to Agreement (“First Amendment”) is made by the **County of Alameda** (“County”) and **Kaiser Foundation Hospitals, on behalf of its Fremont and San Leandro Hospitals** (“Contractor”) with respect to the Emergency Medical Services Primary Stroke Center Agreement (“Agreement”) entered by them with the effective date of January 1, 2023 .

For valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, County and Contractor agree to amend the Agreement in the following respects:

1. Except as otherwise stated in this First Amendment, the terms and provisions of this First Amendment will be effective as of the date this First Amendment is fully executed by both parties.
2. Section 2.1 of the Agreement is amended and replaced in its entirety by the following:
 - 2.1 The term of the agreement shall be January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2026.
3. Section 2.2 of the Agreement is amended to replace “December 31, 2022” with “December 31, 2026”.
4. Section 2.3 of the Agreement shall be deleted and replaced with the following language:
 - 2.3 PSRC designation term will run concurrent with the term in section 2.1 of the Agreement.
5. Except as expressly modified by this First Amendment, all of the terms and conditions of the Agreement, are and remain in full force and effect.
