
Quick Reference Guide Double-Sequential Defibrillation (DSD)

VENTRICULAR FIBRILLATION | PULSELESS VT

Procedure



*** Continue with DSD for the duration of the arrest ***



Should we start Double-Sequential Defibrillation (DSD) as soon as we have two monitors available?

 No. The first 3 defibrillations should be single monitor defibrillations. <u>The 4th</u> <u>defibrillation should be DSD</u>. Continue with DSD for the duration of the arrest.

What manufacturer settings should the monitors be set to for DSD?

- Follow the manufacture setting for the first 3 single monitor defibrillations, and ensure DSD is conducted at the highest available joules setting for each monitor:
 - o Zoll: 200J
 - o LIFEPACK: 360J

What if the patient is ready for the 4th defibrillation, but has been in and out of a shockable rhythm during the arrest, should we still give the 4th defibrillation as a DSD?

 Yes. Whether or not the patient has consistently been in a shockable rhythm or not, the 4th defibrillation should be DSD.



 ✓ Yes. Any combination of monitors is fine, e.g., Zoll and LIFEPACK, Zoll and AED, LIFEPACK and AED.
